What is a concept?

A concept is

- *“a cognitive **unit of meaning** — an abstract idea or a mental symbol sometimes defined as a “unit of knowledge,” built from other units which act as a concept's characteristics. A concept is typically associated with a corresponding representation in a language such as a word.”*

Today, in computer and information science contexts, the term “concept” is often used in loosely defined and inconsistent ways.¹⁾
